As an artist, Warren Khong situates his practice in the investigation of materiality in art to push the possibilities of representation in painting and drawing, as well as their reception. His research explores concepts of painting and its relation to surface and material. Khong is also active in creating paintings for labels, believing that a bottle of fine spirits is a good site for the presentation of an artwork.





The artwork in this is first bottling of Malt, Grain & Cane's Curated Range is a private commission from the artist's "Portrait Series".

## AROMA

Sweet and clean with confectionery notes of strawberry flavoured Laffy Taffy, bubblegum, toasted marshmallows, pineapple, and cherry candy enveloped in nostalgia and memories of youth. Followed by tart notes reminiscent of German Riesling, green grape juice and Greek yogurt. Very approachable, gentle with impeccable notes that cannot be missed. Great opener.

#### TASTE

A distinctive *oomph* emerges with light pepperiness and heat with a continuation of the rich and syrupy confectionary notes filled with icing sugar, cereal milk, vanilla pods, sweet grains, and dollops of whipping cream. Gentle hints of grassiness from grass jelly and Aiyu jelly **DISTILLED** 2022 NOVEMBER

In his current practice, Ian is interested in creating visual narratives, centred around found objects that he finds peculiar, with a specific interest towards the notion of decay or degradation in relation to time as well.

Staoisha is a frequently used term by independent bottlers for heavily peated Bunnahabhain spirits. Its name is derived from the waterbody, Loch Staoisha, located about 2 kilometres, southwest of the distillery.

## **AROMA**

Gentle sweet peat and ash that is reminiscent of smoked salmon in classic Islay chalkiness, coastal brine, and salinity of sea breeze followed by fruity hints of stewed apples, freshly emptied red wine barriques, and apple cider vinegar.

## TASTE

Herbal and medicinal notes of cooked longan, dates, and wolfberries fades out into a light sweetness and brighter acidity with fruitier notes of dried cherries, green mango, honey lemon hard candies that surface. It's vibrance sings in tune with freshly uncorked red wine and a light flinty and gravel edge. **DISTILLED** 2013 OCTOBER 16

#### Youth 青年 Fiona Koh

An artist and graphic designer, Fiona Koh, uses text, images, and objects to explore the ambiguities of language. Part of the series Qing Yi Sè (青一色), the artwork examines the multiplicity of meanings characterised by the word 青 (qing – translated as green). Presented in the form of flashcards that aid the study of a



new language, the text and its translation presented means everything but the colour green.



This Jamaican rum was aged in the tropics for 8 years before it was transported in its original cask and aged continentally for another 3.5 years. Paired with an artwork that utilises the colour Green to reflect its young & youthful spirit, the colour green is at the same time representative of agriculture and hope in the Jamaican national flag – a backdrop very befitting of this young rum cask.

## AROMA

Fresh, vibrant without the usual striking heat one expects with a Clarendon. Comes with notes of classic banana ice cream and cake (the reason we love the Jamaican rums so much) complete with light fusel oil and rancio. It gets sweeter on the nose with notes of caramel, almonds, dried dark fruits, and black plums. A great oak structure that holds on its own with well-paced aromas ending with deeper menthol, fresh rubber tyres and tar.

## TASTE

The red fruits make a fresh and vibrant first impression with light yellow kiwis with cream. A nudge of camphor and menthol as expected from a Clarendon that is reminiscent of teasmoked duck is complemented with notes of licorice, fusel oil and clarified butter or butterscotch and wax. The texture is oily and buttery with the oak notes well integrated. **DISTILLED** 2010 DECEMBER 20



#### Enter the Dragon 见龙在田 Tay Bak Chiang

Singaporean artist, Tay Bak Chiang paints subjects found in the nature of Singapore and Southeast Asia, such as Heliconias, Lotus ponds, and Stones. Works in his Stone series feature textured shapes and sculptural blocks in intense colours, made by combining pigments and traditional Chinese ink. Through these subjects, he expresses his sentiments and philosophies.







Port Charlotte is a heavily peated distillate from the Bruichladdich distillery located in Islay. This rum cask is one of the earliest batches of modern distillate that was produced from the distillery that has since restarted in May 2001.

#### **AROMA**

Gentle yet filled with aromatic nuttiness of peanut shells, black sesame a subtle touch of peaty smoke. Creamy and slightly astringent that plunges into a delightful depth of richness in a tropical fruits galore of apple juice, lemon tea, bananas, and guavas. This same creaminess evolves into creme brûlée that is nice and syrupy with a touch of fresh pine cones.

#### TASTE

Nicely medium-bodied and oily. Lead by a smooth and creamy caramel into notes of peanut cream and walnut oil, all whilst maintaining a clean bite. Pomegranate and cranberries emerge with a punch of black pepper and spice. As it recedes, a mild charcuterie meaty oiliness reveals itself and adds a welcoming touch of umami as an aromatic ash and black tea tannins weave in between. **DISTILLED** 2001 JULY 18

#### Sunset Boulevard Ardhi Putra

Through a VHS player, we enter into the hyper-coloured, funky universe of Ardhira Putra, a Singapore-based Indonesian artist who's been turning his nostalgia into eye-popping works of art. Populating his illustrations & animations with characters, ad tags, and visuals inspired by 1980s & 90s pop culture, this city pop style serves

as a throwback to his beloved boyhood & the heydays of laissez-faire capitalism in Asia.



Malt, Grain & Cane hopes to bring back the good old memories of the past in this artist collaboration with this cask reracked from a Bourbon cask into an Oloroso Quarter cask, in October 2020 before maturing for another 19 months.

#### AROMA

Very fresh, vibrant, and aromatic, with a slight zing brought forth with freshly poured pinot noir red wine, cherries, pomegranates, chocolates, and whiffs of burnt ends. Deeper notes of cut hay, caramelised maltose, toasted barley, and grist, with a more herbaceous vegetal note of freshly cut grass contrasted with a woody acidity.

#### TASTE

Roasted almonds, marzipan, peanut shells – heavier bodied with mildy numbing sensation of Szechuan peppers. As the pepperiness fades, a sweet Sherry and cream takes over with an oilier, richer profile. More fruits emerge with ume plums, peach skins and chestnuts wok-fried and pureed. This Hogshead barrel was reracked into a Barbados Rum barrel (Foursquare Distillery) in November 2021 and finished in this rum barrel for another 8 months. Malt, Grain & Cane marks the end of 2022 with this final bottling.

## AROMA

Gentle soothing wafts of charcoal smoke, highly aromatic, giving off waves of wood and ash. This evolves into a more bright, punchy fruitiness of red fruits such as cherries, pomegranates, cranberries, and red grapes, with light touches of dried orange slices. The lingering notes of chestnuts and cream unfold a creamy, earthy flavour. A harmonious blend of the gentle smoky whisky with its fruit-laden rum cask.

## TASTE

Approachable and smooth as it starts out sweet with a touch of strawberry cream candy with a buttery texture. The sweetness evolves into a slightly more citrusy grapefruit that adds a touch of acidity. The sweet smoke on the nose makes a reappearance – gentle and aromatic. The body is smooth, creamy and shows great balance. **DISTILLED** 2005 OCTOBER 11



# TANCHEN

**TANCHEN Studio** is a collaborative project that focuses on textiles as the basis of their practice. They take a process-based approach to design with a focus on new materials and tactility. From their studios based in Singapore and Shanghai, they create functional textiles that can be used as autonomous elements within a living space. They aim to source and design mindfully as they celebrate the potential of materials, crafts, and techniques

"0/0" (pronounced "zero-zero") refers to wines with minimal intervention. Zero added, and zero removed: just pure fermented grape juice. In the same spirit, we designed this bag by going back to basics. The 0/0 bag's stripped-back design and elastic material mean that it stretches to reveal and take on the object's shape. As wine lovers, we created it specifically to hold large bottles, but it can also be used to carry all kinds of things: fruits, beer cans, tumblers, and much more.

Every bag is handcrafted with zero-waste as our goal. Yarn is measured and cut to ensure that there is minimal wastage of scraps, and each bag is made to order. Easy to fold, scrunch up, and carry around, we hope this also helps reduce the need for single-use plastic or paper bags.

Finally, we were commissioned by MGC to create two new photographic artworks specially for this catalogue. Using the bottles in the 'Curated Range' as the subject, these two new works are found on the front cover of the catalogue, and on page 14.
